



## GUIDELINES FOR GUESTS LODGING AT SISKIYOU FIELD INSTITUTE

### Check-In 4PM | Check-Out 11AM

- ◆ Guests and all belongings must be completely out of the lodge by check-out time.
- ◆ If you are checking in later than 4PM call 541-597-8530 to arrange a late check in.
- ◆ Please call caretaker for late check in or anytime if there is an Emergency at SFI.

### Sitewide Guidelines:

Smoking and pets are not permitted

Quiet time is from 10PM to 7AM

BBQs are allowed under the pavilion only

Please Do Not pick the flowers

Please Do Not move fire pit rocks

Please Do Not use branches for fire pit

### Indoor Lodge Guidelines:

Kendeda House is set up hostel-style, there is no host. All lodge rooms have private bathrooms with showers. The great room, kitchen, and front porch are all shared space.

- Lodge Rooms come with bedding and towels.
- The kitchen has dishes, soaps, utensils and appliances. A refrigerator/freezer and cabinet is available for guests' food storage.
- The Kitchen and Great Room hours are 7AM to 10PM.
- The Kitchen and Great Room are for the use of guests staying in the private rooms only. Please no food or drinks in the Great Room area.

### Outdoor Yurt/Camping Guidelines:

Yurts / Camping Visitors have the use of our solar bathhouse with showers & toilet facilities. They can prepare their meals in our open air pavilion, which offers picnic tables, electricity, and running water. Please do not leave your belongings in the bathhouse overnight.

- Candles, camp stoves or any device with open flame are not permitted inside the Yurts.
- BBQs are allowed under the Pavilion only.
- For health and safety reasons you may not exceed Yurt capacity.
- Bedding/pillows are not included.
- **The House or use of House Kitchen is not available for outside guests.**

Sleeping bags/pillows

Cooler with food & beverages

Camp stove and cooking utensil

Towel/Toiletries
